1. OPEN POSITION: Tenure-Track Associate Professor, Excellent Young Researcher

Working condition: A full-time Associate Professor (tenure-track positions).

Term of office: Five years from the date of appointment

Reappointment and promotion: Based on the achievement at a tenure-track position, promotion to a tenure position, either associate professor or full professor, at completion of the term is possible.

*Outline for the standard in making decision on the approval of academic tenure:

- (1) Scientific achievement in the concerned field is outstanding in both domestic and international research communities.
- (2) Appropriately planned research is sufficiently achieved.
- (3) Educational results to students, namely research instruction and/or the contents of a lecture are excellent.
- (4) He/She obtains sufficient competitive research funding and performs high research activities.

Incentive: The expected financial support is about \(\frac{1}{2}\)6,000,000 for the first two years.

- (5) List of research activities: original scientific papers, review articles, book chapters, other publications, invited presentations in scientific meetings, and awards should be described. Note that name of all the co-authors (in order of appearance) and times cited should be indicated. For our reference, it would be also recommended to include the latest Impact Factor of each journal in the list.
- (6) List of research funds awarded in the past 10 years: period, name of grant, name of the sponsor(s), title of research, whether or not the applicant is Principal Investigator, and the amount of money should be included.
- (7) List of educational experience and research supervisions in university and graduate schools.
- (8) Ambition for future research and education: in two sheets of paper with free format.
- (9) Offprint or photocopy of five scientific papers.
- (10) Name and contact information of two referees: address, telephone number and E-mail address should be indicated.
- (11) Other materials worthy of special mention.
